

PETWORTH HOUSE AND PARK

TUESDAY 13 MAY 2025

Inspired by the Baroque palaces of Europe, and owned by one family for over 900 years, Petworth house displays one of the finest art collections in the care of the National Trust. The state rooms feature a vast collection of paintings and sculpture, including artwork by **Turner**, Reynolds, Gainsborough, and Van Dyck. Outside, the Pleasure Gardens feature formal borders, woodland walks, and architectural features. The 700 acre Deer Park was transformed by Lancelot 'Capability' Brown and is home to ancient trees and fallow deer.

To include 45 minute- One hour Guided Tour. £44 (non National Trust Members) and £25 (National Trust Members). Full payment in advance required. Lunch/refreshments not included.

Depart Goring (railway station) 8.30am, followed by pick up at Pangbourne (opposite village hall) 8.45am. Arrive Petworth House 10.30am. Depart Petworth 3.30pm. Arrive Goring (via Pangbourne) 5.30pm. All timings approximate.
